MAKE WORK EASIER . . . GET THE ON-LINE PLAN ROOM NOW

The Ohio Valley Construction Employers Council has an **ONLINE PLAN ROOM SYSTEM** which allows contractors to create their own account and download all plan room information online to their own systems or to order drawings directly from the OVCEC.

You must be a member of the OVCEC to utilize these plan room services. The fee for access to the on-line plan room, in addition to your yearly membership, is \$25 per month (billed semi-annually or annually). Members may come to the OVCEC plan room to view documents on site. Additional minimal fees will apply for printing, scanning, etc. Plans may also be ordered online and copy and shipping fees will be charged for this service.

7 COMMON WORKPLACE HAZARDS

1. Working at heights.
 - OSHA standards related to scaffolding and ladders are regularly among the most frequently cited citations.
2. Poor housekeeping
 - Your housekeeping program should be based on the philosophy of “clean as you go”.
3. Electrical – extension cords
 - Many electrical citations by OSHA are related to the inappropriate use and condition of extension cords.
4. Forklifts
 - Proper and documented training is mandatory under the OSHA standard.
5. Lockout/tagout
 - Proper lockout/tagout procedures can help prevent serious injuries, but only if those procedures are followed.
6. Chemicals used on the job
 - Understand and follow OSHA’s Hazard Communication Standard.
7. Confined spaces
 - Confined spaces can present a number of hazards. Understand and use the permit system where applicable.

Does your safety program address the proper safety precautions to take and the OSHA compliance requirements for these 7 hazards?
