OSHA Recordkeeping Reminder

- 1. OSHA 300 Log
 - a. Used to classify work-related injuries & illnesses and to note the extent and severity of each case.
 - b. Employers must keep a log for each establishment or site.
 - c. If you have more than one establishment you must keep a separate log and summary for each physical location that is expected to be in operation for one year or longer.
 - i. There is no penalty for maintaining an OSHA 300 Log at sites not in operation for less than one year.
 - ii. Example:
 - 1. Your main office is in Wheeling and you have a construction site in Moundsville that will be in operation for more than a year, then a separate OSHA Log must be maintained.

2. OSHA 300A Summary

- a. Shows the total for the prior year.
- b. Must be posted in a visible location so that your employees are aware of the injuries & illnesses occurring in their workplace.
- c. Must be signed by a company executive.

3. OSHA 301 Incident Information

a. Within 7 calendar days after you receive information that a recordable work-related injury or illness has occurred, you must fill out this form or an equivalent.

4. Reporting of Accidents

- a. All employers are required to notify OSHA when a fatal accident occurs, or suffers a work-related hospitalization, amputation, or loss of an eye.
- b. An in-patient hospitalization, amputation, or eye loss must be reported within 24 hours of learning about it.
- c. A fatal accident must be reported within 8 hours of finding out about them.
